## ABOUT

- Anthony Nappi is an Austin-based psychic and content creator known online as "The Pop Culture Psychic." Loud, funny, and unapologetically himself, Anthony built a completely new lane by blending tarot with celebrity news, internet culture, and current events.
- Originally from Queens, New York, Anthony says he grew up feeling isolated and misunderstood. Bullied throughout childhood for being different and gay, he became fascinated with astrology and tarot around age 12 as a way to understand people and the world around him.
- Anthony says intuition is his strongest skill. He describes himself as someone who instantly picks up on patterns, chemistry, emotions, and relationship dynamics. He jokes that he may be bad at math, but he can spot relationship problems in seconds.
- He accidentally turned tarot into a career while helping care for his father during his battle with cancer. What started as casual livestreams changed when viewers noticed tarot cards in the background and began asking for readings.
- Anthony became one of the first creators to bring tarot into the pop culture space online. Through celebrity readings, true crime cases, and internet drama, he built a massive following and helped create a business model for psychic content creators.
- Known for his unconventional style, Anthony rejects rigid tarot rules. He believes every three cards tell a story and adapts his interpretations to modern life and internet culture, often leading to funny hot takes and debates within the spiritual community.
- Anthony says if he wasn't doing psychic work, he'd be a matchmaker. He believes his real gift is understanding people and relationships, and ultimately wants spirituality to feel relatable like it's coming from a best friend.
