- Cam approaches astrology like a scientist, historian, and provocateur all at once. He believes most people misunderstand astrology because they reduce it to sun signs and memes, while he sees it as a precise system capable of mapping out major life events, relationships, suffering, success, and fate itself. He even created his own astrology app, Startek, because he felt the existing astrology software world "sucked" and needed someone to do it better.
